## **Driver Misclassification Meeting Recap**

On March 31st, 2022 BGS Attorneys Carole Clark Isakson and Erik Ordahl presented a seminar on driver misclassification to members of the Duluth Superior Transportation Association, on which Carole serves as a board member.

Driver classification issues are a critical concern in the trucking industry, and the seminar provided attendees with detailed information on the factors considered by state and federal agencies in determining whether an independent owner-operator should be considered an employee for tax, unemployment, liability, wage and hour and other purposes.

Most tests focus on the control and direction an employer exercises over the driver, and also include analysis related to the economic realities of the relationship. While a strong contract hauling or other agreement between the carrier and driver is helpful to proving that the driver is truly independent, it is critical that the parties follow the contract terms. And because the tests used differ depending on the issue before the particular court or agency, the outcome and analysis can differ even when the facts are very similar. This makes navigating the issues a challenge for motor carriers. Special attention was paid to a California law designated as AB-5 which codified an employee leaning test and has resulted in much concern in the industry — issues relating to this law have been brought to the US Supreme Court.

## **Supply Chain Impacts Recap**

On March 16, 2022, the Transportation Research Forum's Twin Ports and Minneapolis-St. Paul chapters co-hosted a webinar entitled: "Supply Chain Impacts of a Marine Intermodal Container Corridor through Duluth/Superior." Attended by nearly 50 people, the webinar featured a presentation by Jonathan Lamb of Lake Superior Warehousing. Attendees represented industry, shippers, government agencies and academics from both Minnesota and Wisconsin. Lamb explained that in October 2021 Duluth Cargo Connect (a working partnership of Duluth Seaway Port Authority and Lake Superior Warehousing) gained US Customs and Border Protection approval to accept steamshipowned, international shipping containers transported by waterborne vessel. Duluth and Cleveland are the only two ports on the Great Lakes with such approval. Lamb outlined the potential environmental, service and cost benefits of diversifying supply chains by bringing containerized cargo through uncongested alternate gateways versus existing large ports and large inland intermodal ramps. He also addressed drawbacks and possible scenarios for establishing waterborne intermodal service between the Twin Ports and overseas ports, primarily in Europe. Following Lamb's presentation, TRF's national president Joe Schwieterman provided context on the impacts of this opportunity for the Chicago region. The Twin Ports chapter of TRF looks forward to hosting many more events that connect practitioners with students and faculty. https://trforum.org/ trf-chapters/twinports/

It was great to have several DSTA members participate in this webinar. We look forward to coordination between the DSTA and the Twin Ports chapter of the TRF on future joint meetings.
